The Book Award consists of a \$250.00 check to be used for books or supplies needed for your higher education, plus an Award Certificate.

Applicants for the Book Award should complete the Application below and mail it with the accompanying documents to the **McKinley Civic Association, P.O. Box 2384, Jenkintown, PA 19046** by **Friday, April 24, 2009**. Required records for application are:

1. An official record of the most recent high school grade, showing GPA and class standing.
2. SAT scores
3. A school counselor's or a teacher's written letter of recommendation
4. A copy of a letter of acceptance from the institution of higher learning you plan to attend.
5. An original student essay titled, "**Higher Education, The Path to My Future**"

The essay is to be typewritten, double-spaced, and not to exceed three pages in length.

Please note: All applications must include the essay.

The Award Certificate will be presented to the recipient at the school's Awards Assembly. The Book Award check will be mailed to the Recipient upon the Confirmation of Enrollment at the college or institution of high learning. For confirmation of registration, we will accept letters from the registrar, class schedule showing payment of tuition, or receipt of payment of tuition plus photocopy of Student ID card from college. All documents must be on college letterhead.
